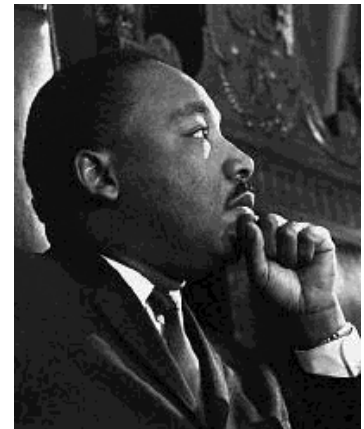

1:00-2:30pm at the Visitor Center

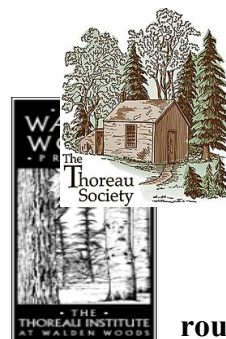
